Examination Details

EXAM-CAPF	Age Limit - 20 to 25 years
EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION	Degree from recognized university with equivalent qualification. Aspirants appearing for their final year graduation exam are allowed to appear for UPSC CPF but are required to submit proof of passing along with the Detailed Application Form which is to be submitted after qualifying the written test, medical standards test and Physical Efficiency Tests (PET).

Selection Procedure-

Central Police Force selection procedure is divided into three stages, including:

Written Test

It is conducted by UPSC. The written exam is consists of two papers, including Paper 1 and Paper 2. Candidates who qualify the written exam will go for Physical Standards/Physical Efficiency Tests and Medical Standards Tests.

Physical Standards/ Physical Efficiency Tests and Medical Standards Tests:

Candidates who are qualified in the written examination will be called for the Physical Standards/ Physical Efficiency Tests and Medical Standards Tests.

Candidates who qualify Medical Standards Tests will be called for Interview/Personality Test.

Final Selection/ Merit
